What are flex credits? For United Way Worldwide members, they are training credits from a portion of your dues that may be applied for approved conferences. You may receive reimbursement for registration fees, travel, lodging, and per diem.

UWW Flex Credits Procedure: You will receive a link via email for your travel reimbursement form **after** the conference is over. You will have **10 business days** to complete your form **online**.
